Incomplete entries may be placed on a waiting list. No entries will be accepted without payment in full. Late entries MAY be accepted at the Show Secretary's discretion. Scratches prior to closing date will receive a full refund less a \$5 office fee. After closing date, NO refunds will be given. Entries may have to sign additional liability waivers the day of the show.

US-460 E to Lynchburg, take the US-29 S exit toward Danville, turn left onto Calohan Road, Continue straight onto Wisecarver Road, turn right onto US-501 S, turn left onto Winfall Road, turn right onto Red House Road, slight right onto Morris Church Road, right onto Hat Creek Road, right onto Hurt Road, follow signs for Horse Show Parking on left. Do not turn onto Hurt from Irving. **NOTE** if you are following GPS do not turn onto Hurt from Irving Dale. Dangerous bridge. Only turn onto to Hurt from Hat Creek.

Other information: Starting times will be emailed to competitors and available by email on the Thursday before the show. Times will also be posted on event Facebook page. All riders, competing or non-competing, at all times on the competition grounds must wear a riding helmet which meets or exceeds ASTM (American Society for Testing and Materials)/SEI (Safety Equipment Institute) standards for equestrian use and carries the SEI tag regardless of age or level. The headgear and harness must be secured and properly fitted. Any rider violating this rule at any time will immediately be prohibited from further riding until such headgear is properly in place. No dogs allowed. Please plan for drinks and snacks accordingly. Dress is casual, but neat and tidy. Half chaps are allowed. Ribbons will be awarded to 6th place. If no age is stated on the entry form, it will be assumed that the rider is a Senior competitor (over 18). Show management reserves the right to combine, divide, or cancel classes as entries warrant. USEF rules will be followed unless otherwise noted by show management.

RELEASE AND WAIVER OF LIABILITY

Toms Performance Horses, LLC and Southwest Virginia Dressage Associations

I, _____, do hereby acknowledge and agree for the good consideration of being permitted to engage in equine activities sponsored by Toms Performance Horses, LLC and Southwest Virginia Dressage Association and located at Hat Creek Equestrian in Brookneal, Virginia, that by engaging in an equine activity, I am participating in an activity that poses potentially serious risk of injury or death to myself and others. By signing this Release and Waiver of Liability, I assume the risk of all of the intrinsic dangers associated with participating in an equine activity, pursuant to sections 3.2-6200 through 3.2-6203 of the Code of Virginia. The intrinsic dangers associated with participation in equine activities are those dangers and conditions integral to participation in equine activities, including, but not limited to: (1) the propensity of equines to behave in ways that may result in injury, harm, or death to persons on or around them; (2) the unpredictability of an equine's reaction to such things as sounds, sudden movement, and unfamiliar objects, persons, or other animals; (3) certain hazards such as surface and subsurface conditions; (4) collisions with animals or objects; and (5) the potential of an equine activity participant acting in a negligent manner that may contribute to injury to the participant or others, such as failing to maintain control over the equine or not acting within the participant's ability. VA Code § 3.2-6200. Additionally, by signing this Release and Waiver of Liability, I waive and release any and all claims or rights to sue that I or my heirs may have in relation to my engagement in an equine activity and those risks assumed above against Toms Performance Horses, LLC, SWVADA, Hat Creek Equestrian, and any sanctioning organization associated with the show or activity; or the board members, show or activity organizers, show managers, show secretaries, employees, volunteers, or family members of any of the heretofore mentioned, collectively or as individuals. It is my intent to give up those rights and hold the above parties harmless, and I do so knowingly and voluntarily. Furthermore, I agree in consideration for and as condition of my being allowed to participate in this equine activity, to hereby indemnify, save, and hold harmless all of those parties heretofore mentioned, from any and all claims of loss, damage, and/or injury to any third party resulting from, arising out of, during course of, or in connection with my participation in said equine activity. This Release and Liability Waiver is presumed effective until such time that written notice is provided by the participant or Toms Performance Horses, LLC, Hat Creek Equestrian.
